# Senior Ball Information/Expectations

- Tickets can only be purchased in advance of the activity in the DSHS Finance Office. When purchasing your ticket, you must provide a current Photo ID **at time of purchase**.
- Students are required to show a photo ID to enter the dance
- No students will be admitted into the dance after 7:30 p.m. Please arrange your transportation in advance in order to meet this expectation for all students; there will be no exceptions.
- Students must arrange to have their transportation arrive for departure pick up no later than 12 a.m.
- Once you have entered the dance, if you decide to leave, you will **not be allowed** to re-enter, and no refund for admission will be given.
- No backpacks or bags will be allowed inside the dance. Purses are subject to search by security at the door.
- All students must be willing to submit to a search for alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products, should administration have **reasonable** cause.

# Senior Ball Information/Expectations

- ***No DSHS student shall have previous/current room reservations at the Sheraton Hotel. (This expectation is also of your guest.) If students are found occupying a room at the Sheraton Hotel, all damage/injury caused to any room or person will be directly the legal responsibility of the occupants. Nearby hotels request that students not book rooms at those locations either.***
- **For students involved in *any* behavior/conduct violation, consequences will be applied, according to the California Education Code, and Davis Senior High School Behavior Standards. This includes, but is not limited to the loss of privilege to attend and/or participate in other senior-related functions (e.g. Graduation, Powder Puff, etc.).**
- All purchases made in support of the Senior Ball must have prior written approval from the class president as directed by the senior class approved Senior Ball budget. Any purchases made on your behalf without advance approval will be considered a donation to the Class of 2011.

# Senior Ball Dress Code

- **Boys' Formal Dress**

- Acceptable: A tuxedo or formal suit, including a collared shirt, tie, and dress shoes are acceptable as well as Dressy pants, including khakis may be worn with a collared shirt and tie and/or sweater. Shirts are to be worn at all times.
- Unacceptable: Jeans are not acceptable. Tennis and athletic shoes are unacceptable.

- **Girls' Formal & Semi-Formal Dress**

- Acceptable: Traditionally formal dresses or gowns may be strapless or may feature spaghetti straps. Exposed backs are acceptable; Dress shoes or dress sandals are to be worn at all times.
- Unacceptable: bare stomachs or bare midriffs are not permitted. Under garments should not be visible. See-through apparel and gowns or dresses with slits that are above the mid-thigh area are not permitted. Garments that are extremely tight or extremely low-cut in the front or back are also unacceptable.

# Senior Ball Dancing

- Inappropriate dancing will be addressed by administration. Students may be asked to leave the dance if they continue to dance inappropriately after they are warned by administration. Inappropriate dancing includes any behavior between or among students that appears sexually provocative.

# Behavior Expectations for Commencement Rehearsal

- Commencement rehearsal is mandatory
- Rehearsal begins Friday, June 11 at 8:30 a.m. sharp in order to finish rehearsal before the extreme heat
- Dress for intense heat and sun. Wear sunscreen and/or hats, but do not bring drinks; we will supply water
- Park in lots 53, 54, 56 or the parking structure on LaRue. Citations will be given for unauthorized parking and are at least \$30.00
- Rehearsal will last as long as necessary so please be prepared to stay focused on the task at hand
- Students found to be under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Grad Night organizers will be notified of the violation

# Behavior Expectations for Commencement

- Students will sit in alphabetical order
- Students must wear appropriate attire
- **Students may not adorn their caps or gowns with personal items including, but not limited to, flags, logos, designs, etc.**
- Students may be removed from the ceremony if found in possession of items including, but not limited to, beach balls, squirt guns, tortillas, etc.
- Students who are found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be removed from the ceremony.

# Behavior Expectations for Commencement

- Students may not yell or leave their assigned seats during the ceremony.
- **Students bringing cell phones and/or cameras will be asked to leave cell phones and cameras with the assistant principals as no cell phones or cameras may be used by graduates during the ceremony. We recommend that students leave cell phones and/or cameras with family members during the ceremony.**
- Students will go immediately to an assigned area to meet with family and friends after the ceremony. This area will be announced in advance and there will be clear directions.
